And, in many large agencies there are multiple tools used to track training from sophisticated systems to paper files. In 2013, the Office of Management and Budget embarked on a quest to find a Learning Management System (LMS) that met all of our learning administrative needs, was easy for State employees to use, and scalable to the diverse needs of individual agencies to Statewide functions. The Delaware Learning Center, "Connecting People with Knowledge", was implemented in 2014 beginning with a pilot by Statewide Training and Organizational Development. Learn about the process, the features, and what's next as implementation continues across the State.
